OVERALL JOB PURPOSE OF THE 3 POSITIONS

The research field officer will be employed to assist with carrying out the "Smart Discharge" study. This process includes assisting the research nurse with consenting and enrolling participants, conducting surveys of the child's caregiver, and conducting follow-up surveys after hospital discharge by phone or in-person by traveling to the participant's home in the community. The research field officer will work closely with a site-based research team, as well as the project team, based at Teaching Hospital of Kigali (CHUK).

JOB REQUIREMENTS AND COMPETENCIES

- Minimum qualification; Bachelor's degree in a related field: IT, Statistics
- At least 1 year experience with prior clinical research studies.
- Strong problem-solving and decision-making skills
- Excellent Communication skills with patients, clinicians, and other members of the general practice team

- Advanced IT skills and prior experience in the use of research applications is an added value

SPECIFIC JOB RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE RESEARCH FIELD OFFICER

- 1. Collection of all data on the ward during hospitalization and by phone or in-person at the child's home after discharge
- 2. Ensuring safety and confidentiality of the data collected
- 3. Work hand in hand with the Smart Discharges research nurse team and the child's clinical team, to ensure accurate sharing of data, consistent quality in data collection and seamless clinical and research activities.

- 5. Assist with data entry, organization, and upkeep of databases
- 6. Work hand in hand with the Research Nurse Supervisor to ensure accuracy and completeness of





the data collected
